

Team Officials Code of Conduct

As an official with a Tasmanian Team I agree to:

- Abide by Orienteering Australia's Member Protection Policy, a copy of which I have been provided with, and sign the Prohibited Persons Declaration.
- Abide by OT's policies, including Code of Conduct, Privacy Policy, and Child Protection Policy, copies of which I have been provided with.
- Place the safety and welfare of the participants above all else.
- Accept the responsibility for my actions and those of others under my direction while not absolving Orienteering Tasmania from its duty of care.
- Be impartial, having proper regard for rights and obligations of all others.
- Avoid acting in an official capacity where a conflict of interest might be perceived.
- Be courteous, respectful and open to discussion and interaction.
- Value the individual in sport.
- Seek continual self improvement through study, performance appraisal, and regular updating of competencies.
- Be a positive role model in behaviour and appearance.
- Refrain from any form of personal abuse towards athletes.
- Show concern and caution towards sick and injured athletes.
- Respect the right of each individual to be involved in the activities, events and tasks of the Association as chosen.
- Respect the law and customs of the places visited.
- Respect the confidentiality of any disclosed information.
- Maintain a current Working with Vulnerable People card
- Refrain from offering team members alcohol or drugs at any time (unless prescribed for medical conditions).
- Ensure I have a zero blood alcohol level at all times when transporting team members.
